COURSE OUTLINE

The aim of this course is to develop an understanding of autism and give practical suggestions of how to enhance current provision in your own setting

Course content includes:

- A consideration of the theories of autism and how this understanding influences the educational frameworks we use.
- A practical session on the use of iPads for individuals and small group work.
- An opportunity to listen to parents speak of their experiences of bringing up a child with autism

Greater awareness of what it means to be on the autistic spectrum and a bank of practical ideas and suggestions that can be shared and implemented in your own setting
