NPQML - Leading a team within an organisation

The National Professional Qualification for Middle Leadership (NPQML) is a qualification that provides national recognition of leadership development and professional achievement as a middle leader. It is designed to support participants in becoming highly effective middle leaders with the skills, confidence and knowledge to drive successful team performance and improved classroom practice.

Who is the NPQML for?

The NPQML is for individuals with responsibility for leading a team, from newly appointed to more established and experienced leaders. For example:

Subject/curriculum leaders
Key stage leaders
Heads of department
Pastoral leaders, e.g. Head of Year or Head of House
Gifted and talented coordinators
SLEs
Assessment coordinators
Career coordinators

What is the NPQML programme?

NPQML sits at level one of the leadership curriculum (Level 2 is the NPQSL and level 3 the NPQH) for the National College for Teaching and Leadership. To achieve the qualification, participants will need to complete two Essential modules ('Leading teaching' and 'Managing systems and processes') and one Elective module (chosen from a range of options).

Included in the cost of the programme will be:

- Full day, face to face training for each module (with lunch included)
- Online materials for the two Essential modules and one Elective module
- Online discussions and support
- Peer group meetings
- A 360 degree diagnostic

As a national qualification, the NPQML may be used to contribute towards Master's Level Study at a number of universities across the country.





How is the programme assessed?

Accreditation is assessed though one extended school improvement task that relates to the leadership role and to the school's improvement priorities. This task will need to draw on learning from all the modules studied, particularly the two Essential modules, and include a brief evaluative paper summarising learning from the Elective module.

The work for this task will be undertaken over at least two terms to enable the leader to show evidence of the impact of leadership.

How long does it take?

The qualification can take between 6 and 18 months to complete with each module requiring between 40 and 50 hours of learning (face to face sessions, online and workplace learning). The majority of middle leaders are likely to spend 12 months completing the programme.

How much does NPQML cost?

The National College no longer offers scholarships for the NPQML, however, we are pleased to be able to offer this programme for the reduced price of £845 + VAT. This is substantially below the National College recommended retail price of £1050. This is a non-refundable charge and must be paid once the place has been confirmed by Discovery.

NB this is likely to be the last year that there will be no assessment charge.
