Package A—Developing English.

- Improving spelling—creative ideas to develop children's understanding of spelling rules and embed the strategies in their writing
- Developing reading fluency—increase accuracy, pace, intonation and comprehension skills. Benefits of embedding these skills are seen in all areas of the curriculum
- A new approach to writing moderation—compare and rank writing to develop progression across the school and address gaps in learning.
